WHATIS MEDIA LITERACY?

- Understanding and critically evaluating broadcast, digital and other media content and services, in order to make informed choices and best manage media use
- 2. Accessing and using broadcast and digital media content and services in a safe and secure manner, to maximise opportunities and minimise risks
- 3. Creating and participating, via media, in a responsible, ethical and effective manner, in the creative, cultural and democratic aspects of society

- The MLI Awards open for applications on 15th December and close on 10th February 2023

BEST YOUTH-LED MEDIA LITERACY INTERVENTION

this category includes any project, iniatitive or activiy created by, or delivered by school age (5 - 18), that promoted at least one of the skills outlined in the BAI media literacy policy

BEST MEDIA LITERACY INTERVENTION

this category includes any project, programme or intervention that promoted at least one of the skills outlined in the BAI media literacy policy

To note: Applications should focus on projects, initiatives, interventions and activities that promote at least one of the skills outlined in the BAI Media Literacy Policy and must have been delivered between February 2022 and February 2023

MEDIA LITERACY MEDIA CHAMPION

this category recognises the work of a person or organisation that has raised the profile of media literacy in Irish media

MLI MEMBER SPECIAL CONTRIBUTION

this category recognises the specific contribution an MLI member has made to the promotion of media literacy
